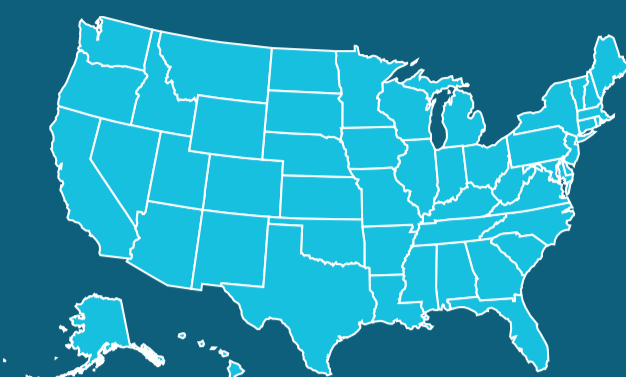

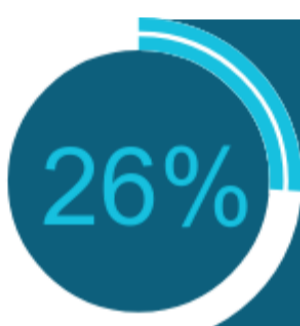

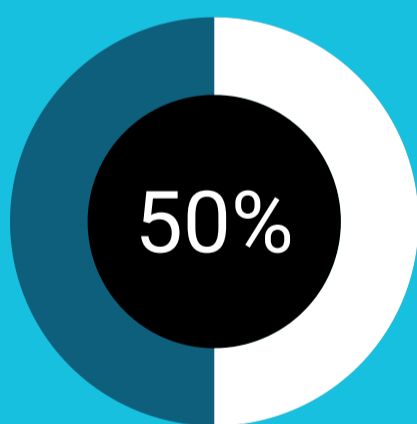
of Americans believe that life begins at or before heartbeat.



of pro-choice respondents stated abortion would not be an option for their own unplanned pregnancy.



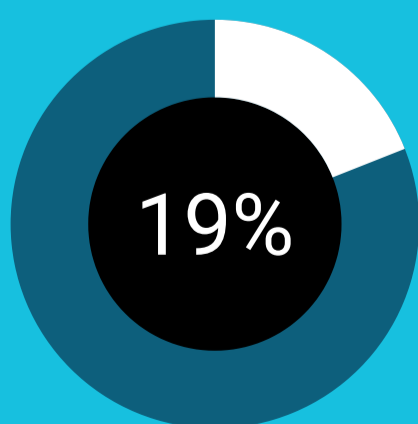
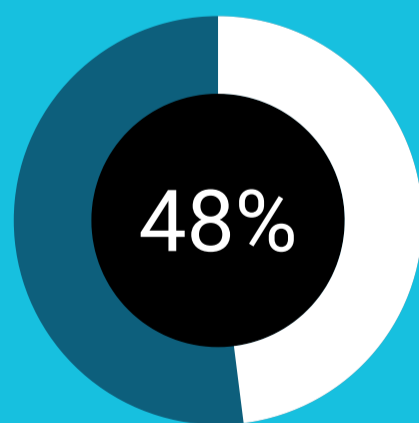
of respondents who identified as pro-choice stated "maybe" when asked if abortion would be an option for their own unplanned pregnancy.

Research completed by Magid, paid for by Save the Storks. Online interviews were conducted with 1,000 adults (18-69 year old) living across the country. Interviews were conducted in May 2019. A stratified random sample procedure based on gender, age-group, ethnic background, and area across the United States was used to insure the sample reflected the United States demographics, so the results could be generalized to the population. Care was taken to insure the survey would be unbiased.
